LETTER FROM THE DIRECTOR

When I first arrived at the Ruth Enlow Library, one of my first priorities was to create a Strategic Plan to guide our steps in the years ahead. Over the years we were able to accomplish quite a lot of the goals on that plan, successfully repositioning the Library as a valued and public-facing partner for many groups and as a haven for readers, students and lifelong learners in Garrett County. While COVID impacted our plans (as it did everyone else's), we are proud of the progress we made, and of what the Library has shown it can do for its patrons.

While preparing this Strategic Plan I was reminded of the value that the process holds. Developing this plan helped me reconnect with that and see what has changed and what has stayed the same in the intervening years. Based on this input, we have developed a set of goals that I believe represent a firm path forward; a path that brings the Library and its resources to the support of the people and groups it serves in meaningful and potentially life-changing ways. These goals will be reviewed annually, and our work towards meeting them will be guided by the values we have adopted, values which I believe represent the vision of positivity that libraries offer their communities.

In developing a culture of reading, we expand horizons, support mental health and provide an avenue for lasting lifelong learning for all users. In serving the County's educational needs, we strengthen the schools as well as the parents who choose to educate at home, ensuring access to quality resources and services. In fostering human connection in a hybrid world, we help build resilient communities based in real-world connections, give people a meaningful social outlet and help them learn about and strike a balance with the technology that at times threatens to overwhelm us.
