- · Contest runs March 17, 2023 through April 14, 2023
- · Bookmarks judged on originality, design, and reproducibility
- Use this entry form or an exact photocopy of the same size (Do not enlarge or reduce the size)
- · The design can be vertical or horizontal
- · Original entries only, created by the contestant
- Do not trace or use copyrighted images, such as cartoon characters
- Design theme must reflect "What does the library mean to you?"
- Contest is open to ages 6 and up
- · All entries must be clear and reproducible
- If you include words, check for correct spelling and that writing is clear and fits the space well
- · No computer generated artwork
- · Avoid fluorescent or neon colors
- Make sure the colors are filled in and solid (Sketching does not reproduce well)
- Keep important design details away from the line around the box

All entries become the property of the Ruth Enlow Library, and the winning designs will be printed and distributed as Ruth Enlow Library bookmarks. Winning designs also will be posted on the Library's website and social media pages.
